

One (1) position of Non-key expert for MediPIET project

Important:

Requirements

- University degree in health sciences and master’s in public health or epidemiology
- Fluency in spoken and written English*
- At least 10 years professional experience in Epidemiology and/or Public Health
- Proven international experience in strengthening field epidemiology programs.
- Proven experience of at least 5 years in developing material for and delivering online courses.
- Proven experience of at least 5 years as director of online epidemiology courses.
- Other requirements:
 - Be a Spanish citizen or a national of a member state of the European Union or be a national of any State that, in accordance to an International Treaty concluded by the European Union and ratified by Spain, allows free movement of workers
 - Nationals of other States that hold a residence and working permit in Spain
 - In all situations, the workers must be able to fulfil the provisions of the Article 7 of the Workers’ Statute Law approved by Royal Legislative Decree 2/2015, of October 23

Merits

- At least 5 years on field epidemiology related work
- At least 10 years of professional experience in training epidemiology
- Proven experience with Field Epidemiology Training Programme (FETP)
- Proven experience in tutoring professionals in epidemiology and/or Public Health
- At least ten publications in index journals
- Knowledge of Spanish language *
- Availability to travel

* At the discretion of the Selection Committee, level tests and interviews may be carried out in English and/or Spanish.

Tasks:

Main tasks:

- To be fully integrated in the MediPIET “Scientific Team” as scientific coordinator.
- To collaborate in the organization and contents of all scientific and training activities (included MediPIET’s Training of Trainers, ToT)
- To develop instructional design, content, teaching materials and pedagogical methods of MediPIET training programme for online delivery, and face-to-face secondarily.

Additional tasks:

- To identify projects, activities and international assignments for the MediPIET fellows, based on the MediPIET core competencies and curriculum
- To provide technical support and monitor the fellow’s progress
- To supplementary provide distance-tutoring for MediPIET fellows
- To supplementary supervise portfolio elaboration
- To contribute to training of trainers
- To support cascade training in countries
- To promote the MediPIET programme

In particular, these activities encompass the following areas:

- Coordinate the organization of online and face-to-face courses and training modules, and their subsequent evaluation
- Identify and develop training materials for course work, including practical case studies. Develop the training modules according to the MediPIET training curriculum
- Provide pedagogical support/tutoring to MediPIET fellows and guidance to supervisors/trainers/course facilitators
- Identify, assess and promote project opportunities and assignments for the “learning by doing” training of the fellows, including international assignments
- Closely liaise with the MediPIET partner institutions within the framework of the MediPIET “Training Sites” and “Training Centre Forum”
- Identify training needs for the supervisors
- Monitor and promote MediPIET host Training Sites developments
- To contribute/advise on the strategic development of the programme
- Represent MediPIET in relevant scientific meetings and conferences
